

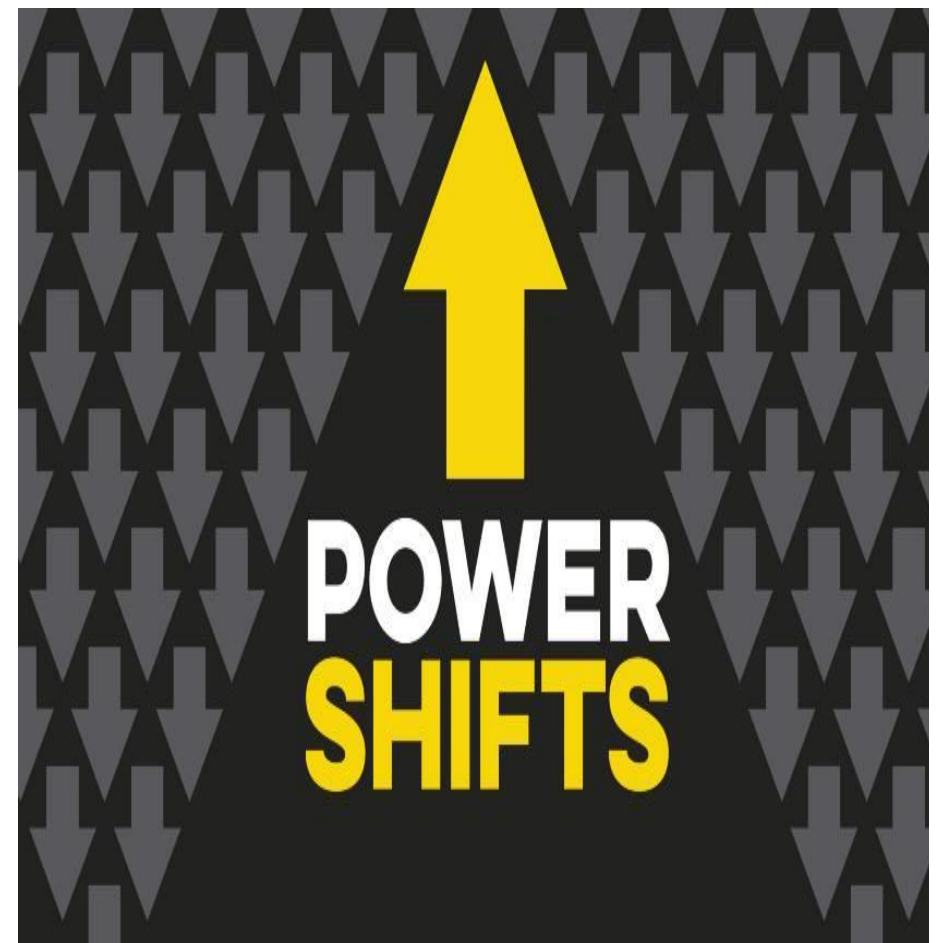

Power Shift #1 - Attitude

"The greatest among you will be your servant," **Matthew 23:11**

"Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant." **Philippians 2:5-7**

"Jesus knew that the Father had put all things under his power," John noted, "and that he had come from God and was returning to God; so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him." **John 13:3-5**

"When he had finished washing their feet, he put on his clothes and returned to his place. "Do you understand what I have done for you?" he asked them. "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am. Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. Very truly I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them."

Three Kinds of Servant - from Biblical Greek

*"Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone to obey him as **slaves**, you are **slaves** to the one whom you obey - whether you are **slaves** to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you wholeheartedly obeyed the form of teaching to which you were entrusted. You have been set free from sin and have become **slaves** to righteousness."* **Romans 6:16-18**

*"Jesus called them together and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your **servant** (**diakonos**), and whoever wants to be first must be your **slave** (**doulos**) - just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."* **Matthew 20:25-28**
